

Cognitive Development

Our lesson plans are designed to help encourage healthy cognitive development. Language acquisition is just beginning to develop amongst toddlers. Our goal is to help children explore Spanish through imitation and reinforcement tactics. Children demonstrate skill in discriminating sounds: Spanish phoneme, language patterns, and pronunciation. Children use memory and association to recall words, build vocabulary via Spanish songs and music. Interactive play allows children to identify Spanish names of objects and events, use Spanish language to explain ideas and feelings, imitate and recognize Spanish letters and numbers, and demonstrate an interest in using writing for completing worksheets, making signs, and pictures.

We provide instructional aides and learning cards for parents and teachers to encourage effective learning. Children are active participants in group activities as well as independent activities such as designing their own learning cards which helps them to increase memory on a given subject.
