Our lesson plans are designed to help encourage healthy socio-emotional development. Children identify oneself as a member of a specific family and cultural group and understand the significance of integration of familial customs and backgrounds. We promote diversity in learning Hispanic heritage and cultural norms. Group activities allow children to develop positive relationships with their peers. Children are encouraged to work cooperatively with others and share their ideas and feelings about their learning experiences.
